## **Class 3 Trip**

Class 3 will be going on a trip to the Mercer Art Gallery and the Royal Pump Room Museum in Harrogate on Tuesday the 10<sup>th</sup> of July. The trip will ensure the children have the chance to handle real artefacts from ancient Egypt, look at the museum collection, dress up as an Egyptian, discover the uses of replica artefacts and see a real mummy!

We will cross the road to picnic on the grass in the beautiful Valley Gardens.

During the afternoon the children will have chance to continue their learning on Ancient Egyptians. with crafting sessions, which then use what they have created in hands on activities linked to mummification.

Children will need a packed lunch and drink, in a rucksack. School is providing one for those children who requested one.
