Each child has been given a £1 book token to celebrate World Book Day on 1st March. The tokens can be used in booksellers or through Usbourne Books from 26th Feb to 25th March.

World Book Day/Sponsored Read or Listen

On Thursday 1st of March it is World Book Day and we are celebrating the special event in school and highlighting the importance and enjoyment of reading for all our children. We are working with Lindsey Whaley our local Usborne Book organiser to carry out our sponsored read on the same day. This will include reading going on across the day in school with each class taking part during the day (including Nursery). To work alongside this we would like the children to dress up as their favourite book character and bring in the book the character is from. We can then use these in sharing our books with others as part of the sponsored read events happening in classes. Lindsey will be in school in the morning reading to some of our younger children as they can take part in a Sponsored Listen. It is also possible for the children to use their Book Tokens through Usborne. Today each child has brought home a sponsor form for the sponsored read and from the money raised we will be able to purchase a range of books for each class across the school to support their reading and also their learning across the curriculum.

Children need their PE KIT in school every week. Please could you bring on a Monday and take home on a Friday to wash. It is a good idea to have some tracksuit bottoms in the bag as the weather is colder.
