From 4pm to 6pm on Wednesday 31 October you can join our qualified forest school event leader 'Mystic' Kirsten Civil for activities including woodland crafts, making stick wind chimes, spirits of the forest floor art, finding your tree twin and making a broomstick.

Cooking on the woodland fire; tomato soup and a cheesy bread roll, croissants on a stick & toffee apples, hot or cold drink.

Storytelling: the children will be involved in finding the signs of magical and enchanted creatures that live in the forest. We will make a story to go with our session and re-tell by the light of the campfire!

Booking is essential for this event, under 16s need adult supervision. In the event of adverse weather, the forest school event will be cancelled. This activity will involve some tool use.
