Class 4 Rivers days We have through the National Rivers Trust , 2 days planned for Class 4.

26th June We have a mobile classroom coming into school where the children will learn about rivers and run activities with small groups of children on the Rivers Table, Natural Flood Management and river invertebrate identification.

27th June we have Gordon MacLellan of Creeping Toad, to run an extension activity for literacy. The day will include storytelling - listening to some river and river animal stories, working in groups using pictures and big drawings to create some collective poems about rivers and river processes then going on to work as individuals maybe on river animal stories, maybe turning ideas and stories into pop-up river landscapes with stories built into the constructions. Through all this, children would be developing new imagery, extending language, playing with the sound and rhythms of words. They will create stories and find visual ways of remembering them and embedding the new language.

Puppet Show at the Nash 4th July (www.lempen.co.uk)

We are very fortunate to have a Lempen Puppet Theatre company visiting the Nash.

Both key stages will have the opportunity to watch: The Amazing , at 2 separate performances. Both will have an opportunity to talk to the puppeteers after the performance to ask questions about their role as a puppeteer.

The Nash and The PTFA has joint funded this experience for our pupils.

Lempen Puppet Theatre Company, founded in 1987, is one of Britain's great touring theatre companies. They tour extensively all over the UK, and have appeared at various festivals, theatres and schools in Austria, Belgium, Chile, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Liechtenstein, Luxemburg, Romania, Switzerland, Taiwan and Turks & Caicos.

Professionally trained in puppetry, mime, music, mask and sculpture, they specialise in modern day myths that connect the imagination to real and contemporary issues.
